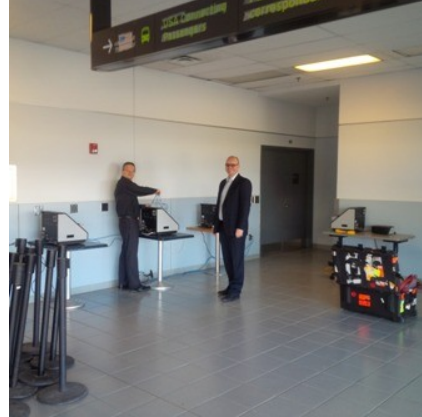

Screening of People at Pearson International Airport to Welcome The Prime Minister of India and Canada Using Teknoscan Aspiration and Detection Equipments



In collaboration with the RCMP and Reilly Security Teknoscan provided explosives detection equipments to screen 500 people coming to welcome the Prime Minister of India and Prime Minister of Canada at special location at Pearson International Airport.

The Security measures also involved screening people and their luggage travelling with the PM of India.

April 13, 2015 Deployment of Teknoscan Explosives detection equipments for screening Cars at the Rogers Center for the Blue Jay Game

The Rogers Center through Reilly Security requested Teknoscan to provide explosives detection equipments at the site to screen all vehicles entering the underground parking lot before the start of the Blue Jay Game.

The screening was successfully carried out in collaboration with the CBRNE Metro Police force, Rogers Center security people and Reilly team. Positive detection resulted in denial entry to the parking area.



March-April 2015 Pilot Run of Teknoscan equipments at the CN Tower for Screening people and their carry-on luggage

Batch screening of people for firearms and explosives were successful deployed at the CN Tower for a period of six weeks. The pilot run demonstrated the capability of the equipments to batch screen people and their luggage enhancing security, reliability and processing time.

The equipments were also used for checking parcels and items coming to the receiving area of the facility.



Arrangement is being made to deploy Teknoscan solution at Parliament Hill to screen all incoming vehicles for firearms, explosives and other threat materials. This effort is being coordinated with the RCMP/CBRNE Operations in Ottawa.
